Coller (University of Michigan) Surgical Society, Northeastern Colon and Rectal Society, the Society of Laparoendoscopic Surgeons, the Society of American Gastrointestinal Endoscopic Surgeons.

Resulting studies have appeared in such peer-reviewed journals as *The American Journal of Surgery*, *American Surgeon*, *Journal of the Society of Laparoendoscopic Surgeons*, and *Surgical Endoscopy*. He is a coauthor of the chapter "Colon, Rectum, and Anus" that appeared in *Hardy's Textbook of Surgery*. Dr. Nejman is a primary teacher of colonoscopic procedures to the general surgery residents. He was first appointed to a teaching appointment at Temple University School of Medicine in 1987
